Students are required to complete **four (4) core subjects** and can **choose between three (3) elective subjects** per semester or **two (2) elective subjects** and **one (1) accelerated VCE subject**.



2024 VCE Subject Acceleration at Year 10

Year 10 is a particularly exciting time as students have the opportunity to accelerate and commence **one** VCE subject, should they **choose**.

New structure = Non compulsory requirement for students in Year 10.

Why accelerate?

Focus on one VCE subject as a first experience, instead of six subjects (when in Year 11).

The subject chosen is usually an area of focus, which increases the likelihood of doing well.

Additional subject = increase ATAR score (up to 10%)

Does **NOT** mean that less subjects are completed in Year 12.

2024 VCE Subject Acceleration at Year 10

Acceleration Expression of Interest Process:

Students will be required to register their interest when they fill in the **online subject selection form**. Acceleration viability will also be discussed during the **1:1 interview**.

The subject teacher will be involved in the decision to approve /not approve the students wish to accelerate. Current and past academic progress will be considered along with future pathways (Tertiary level).

Note: The acceleration subject **will** take the place of one Elective block, meaning this student will complete two Elective subjects per semester instead of three (in 2024).

Acceleration students are **still required** to complete their compulsory Year 10 History & PE elective subject (one in each Semester in 2024).

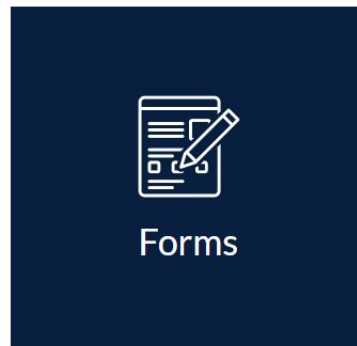
